## *CO2e mitigated*

The amount of CO2 measurements not emitted into the atmosphere. When food enters the landfill, it produces a dangerous methane gas that harms our atmosphere. When we decreased food waste we also decrease the harmful effects that it creates to our environment.

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## *S.H.A.R.E. programs*

Schools have implemented the S.H.A.R.E. refrigerated programs to store wholesome leftovers. Average 50lbs of food per day per school recovered. Daily goal to: Stop Hunger And Restore Earth; helps students respect food resources and refuel!
